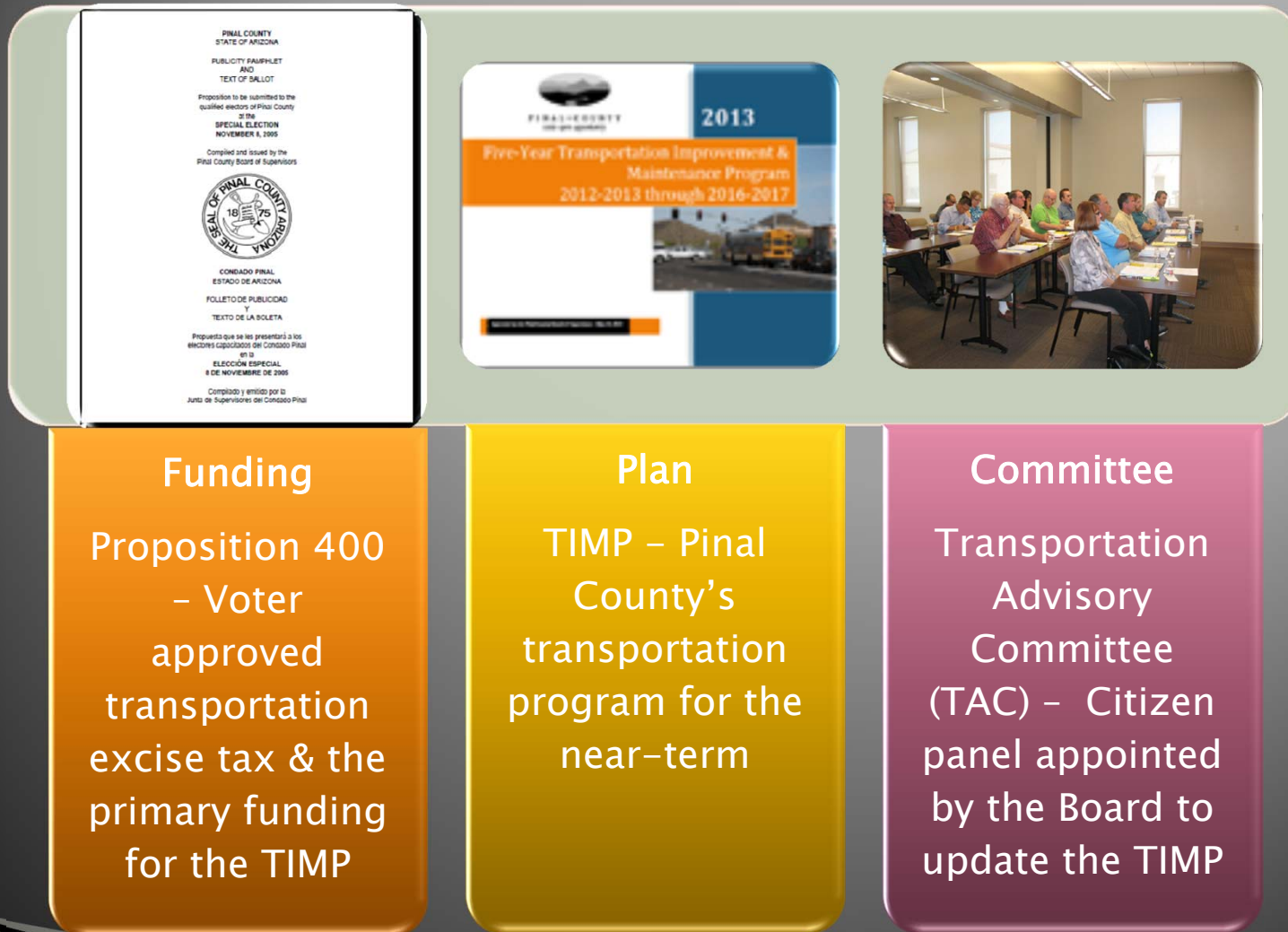

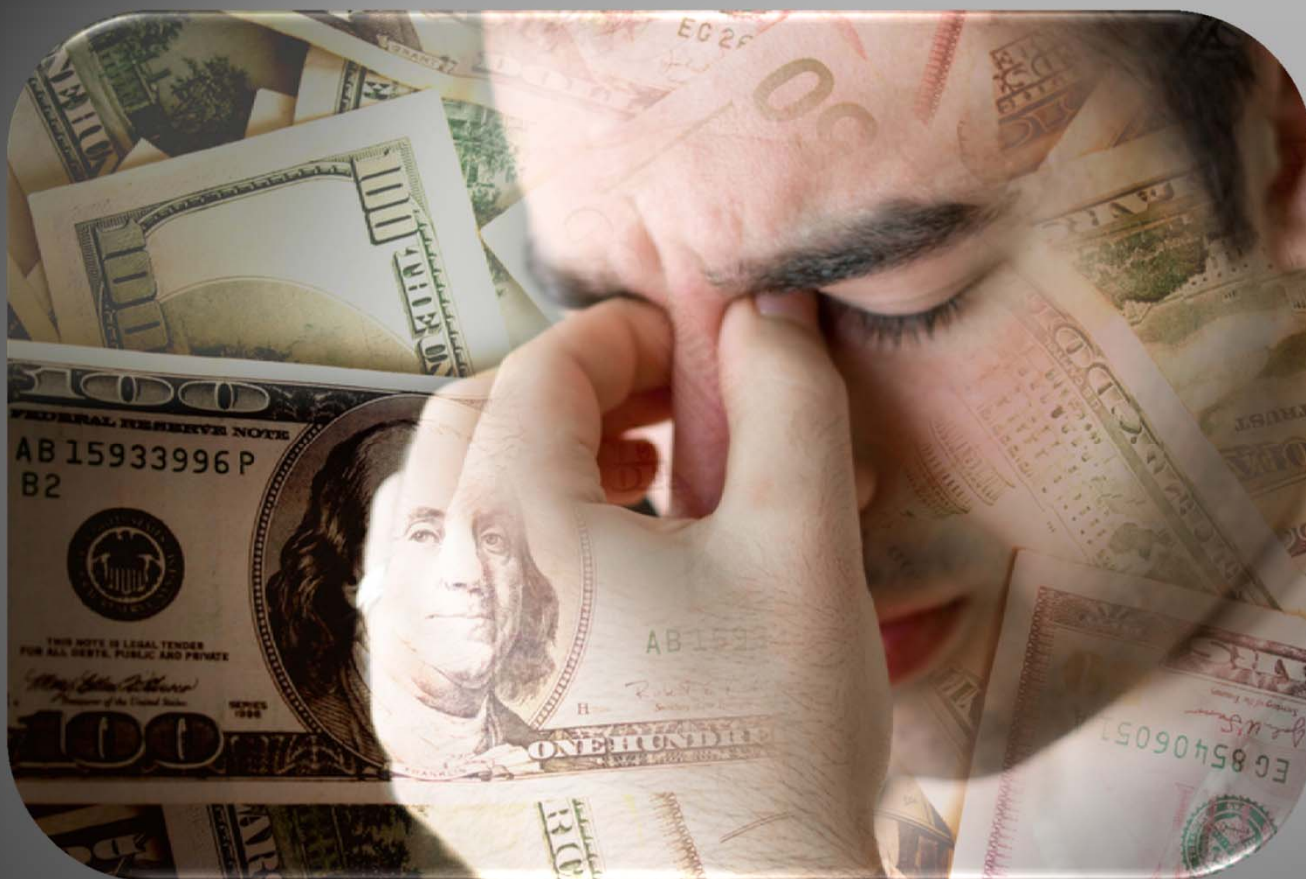

# 5-Year Transportation Program



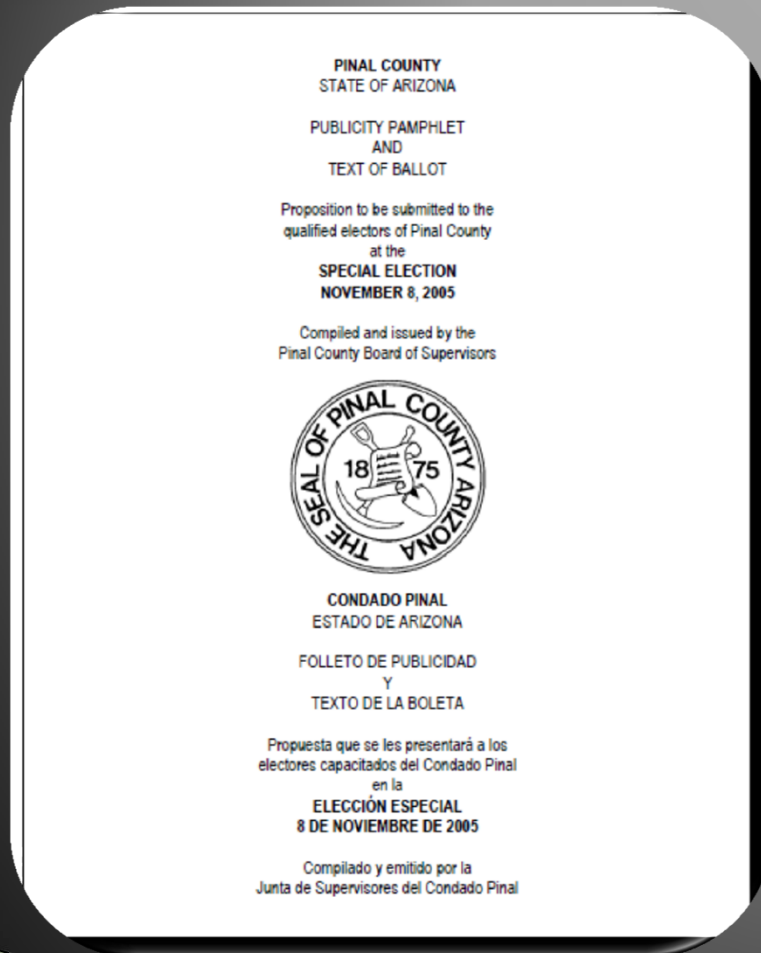

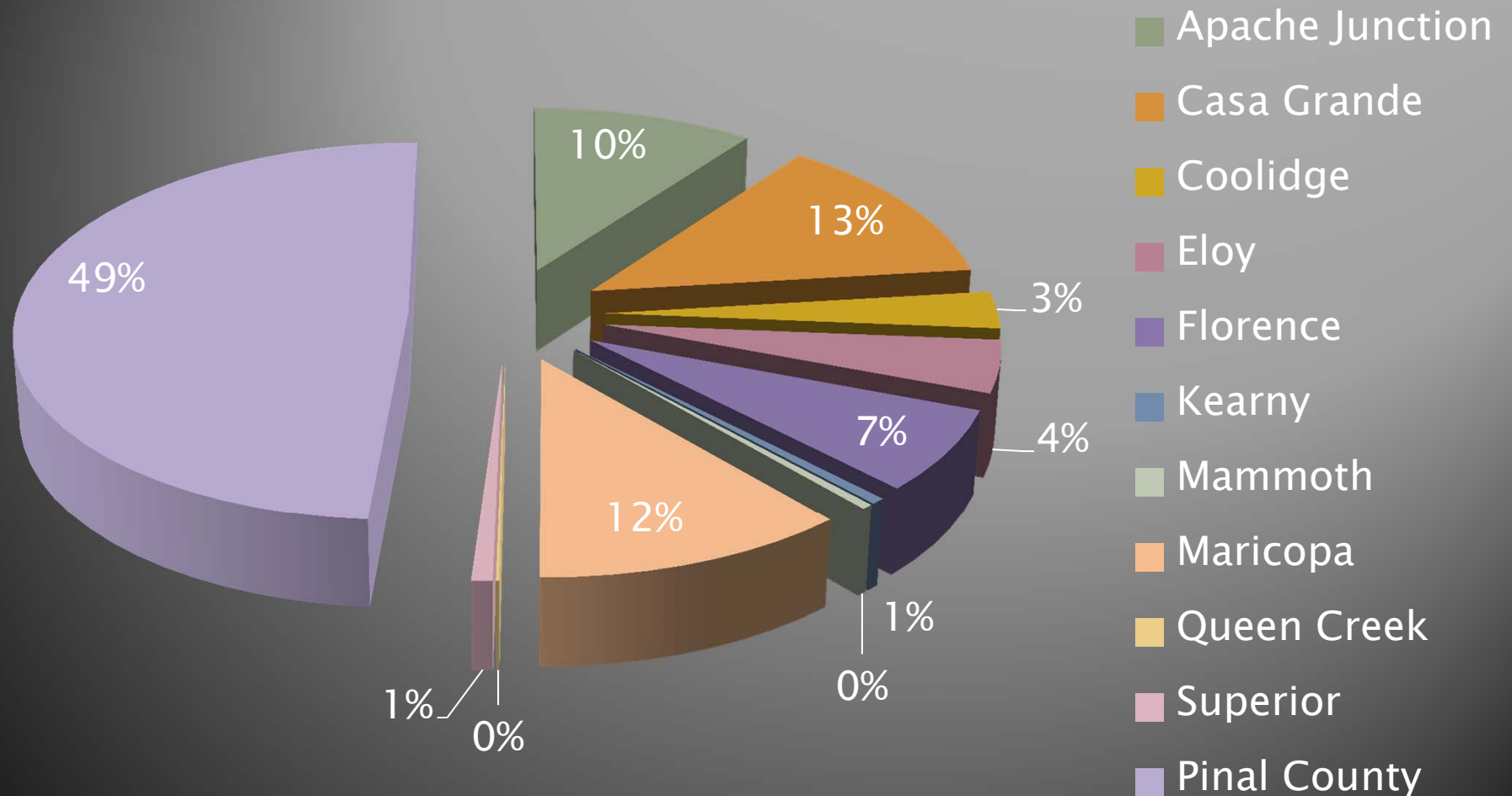


# Proposition 400 & Population Factor

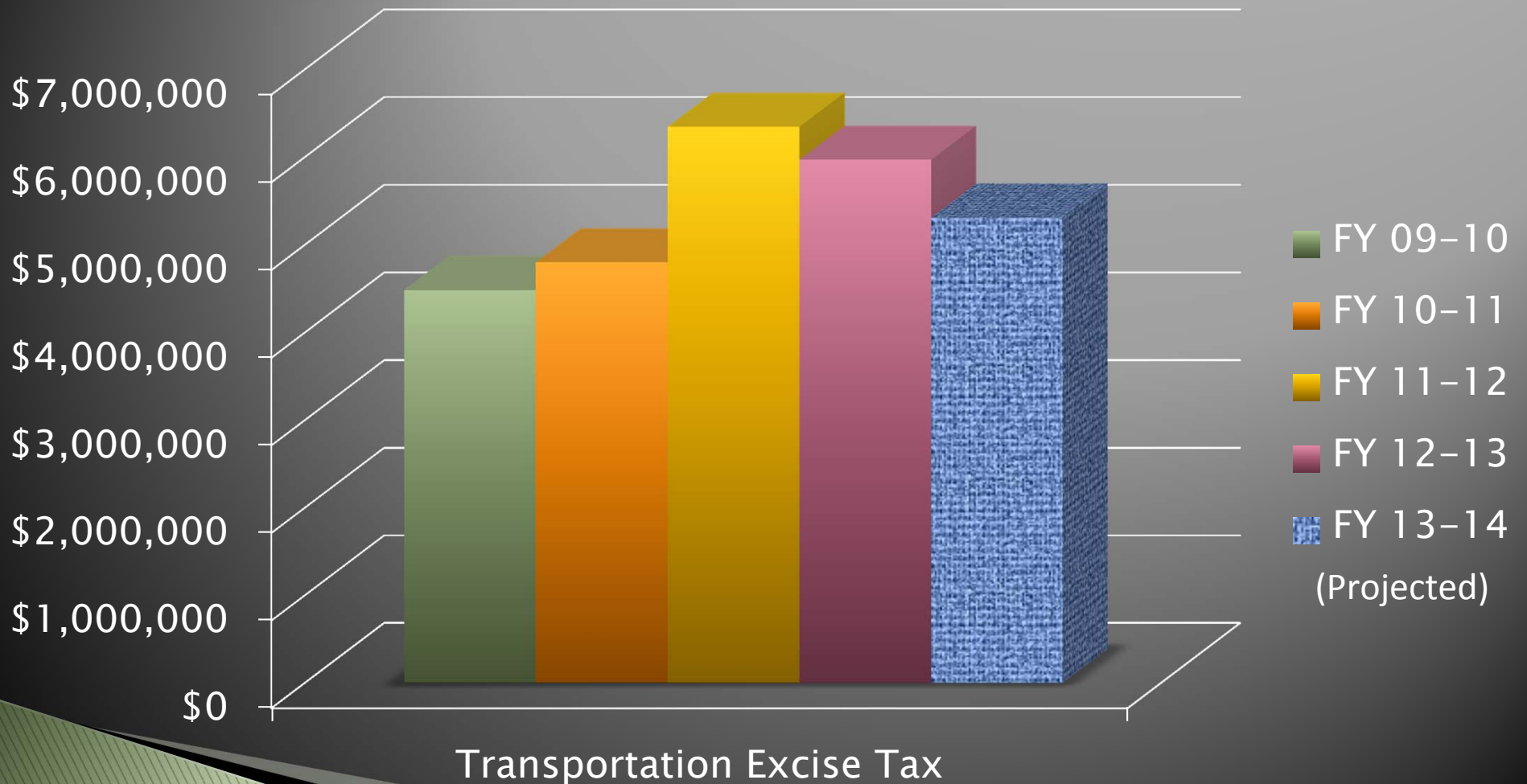


- ▶ Distribution of revenues

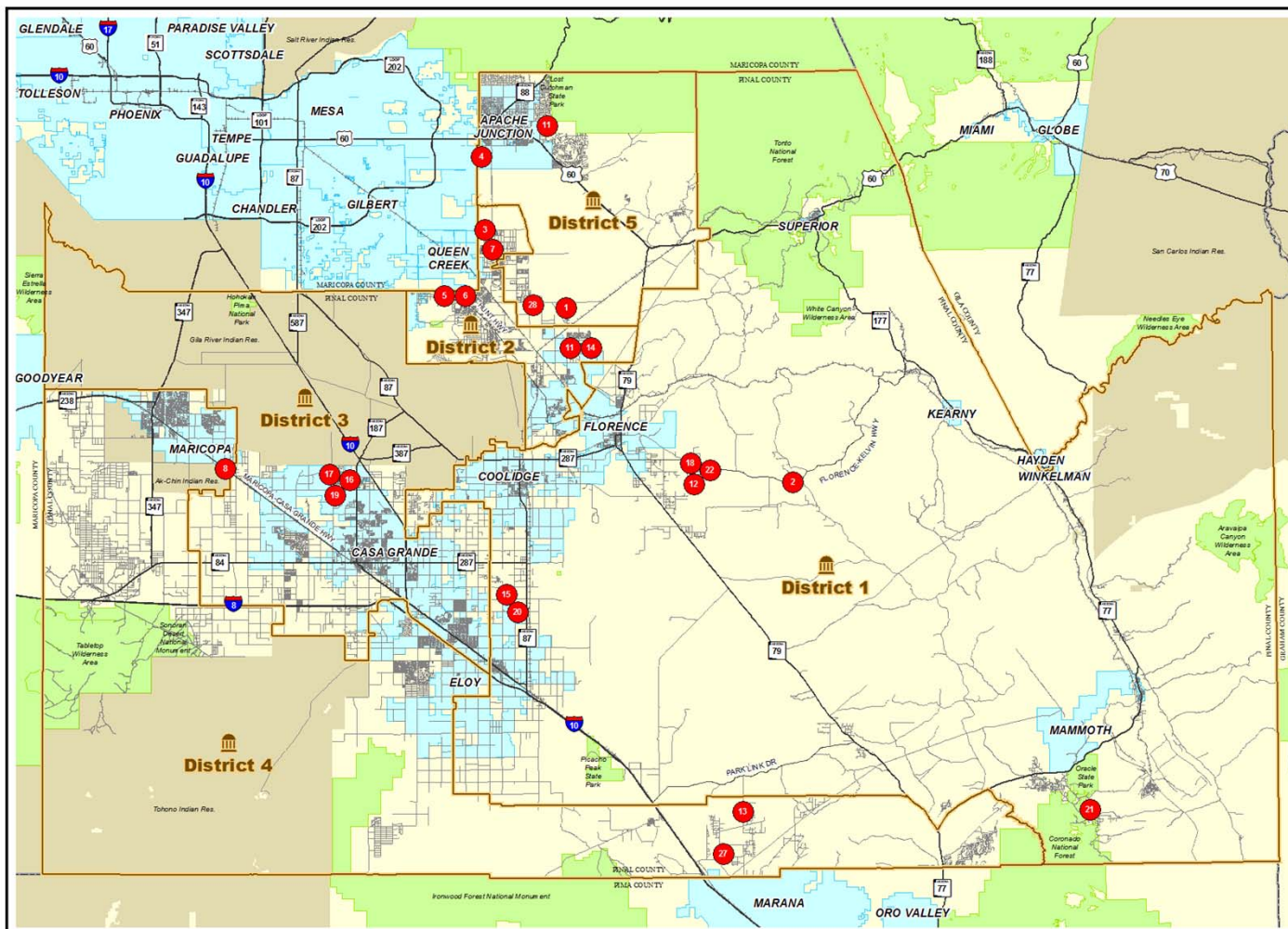
## Traffic Flow

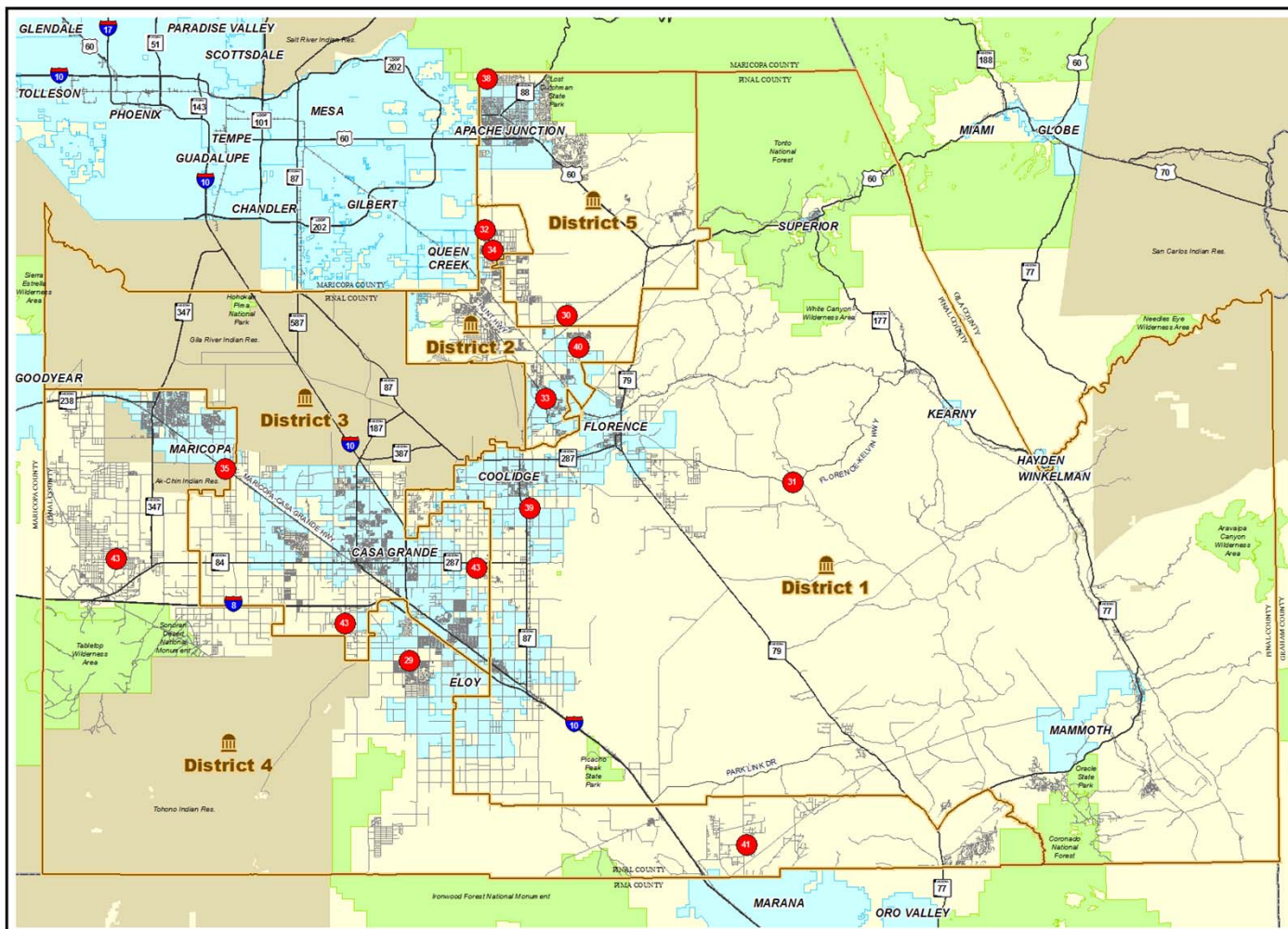

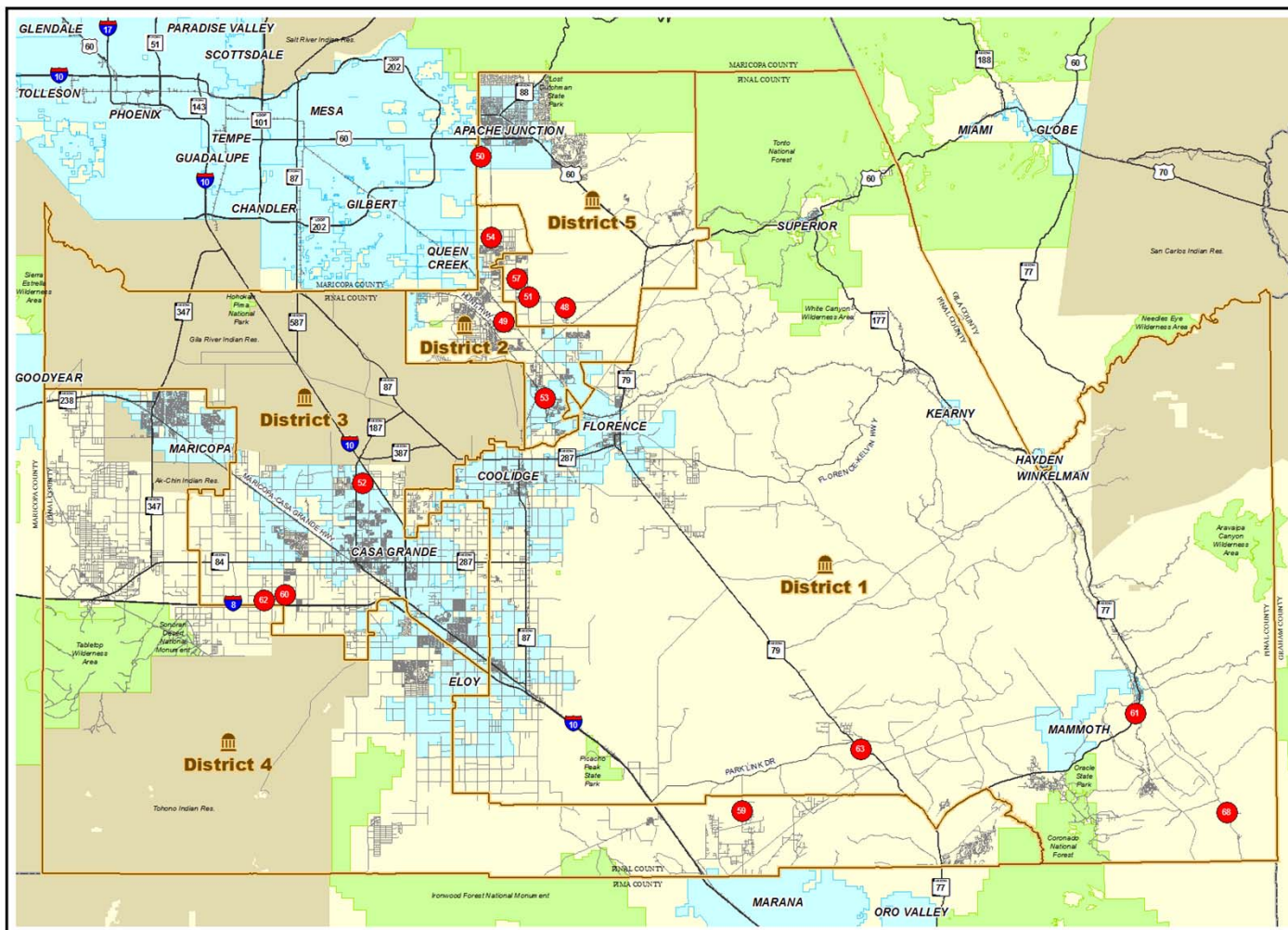
### Five-Year Transportation Improvement & Maintenance Program Budget Year 2013-2014

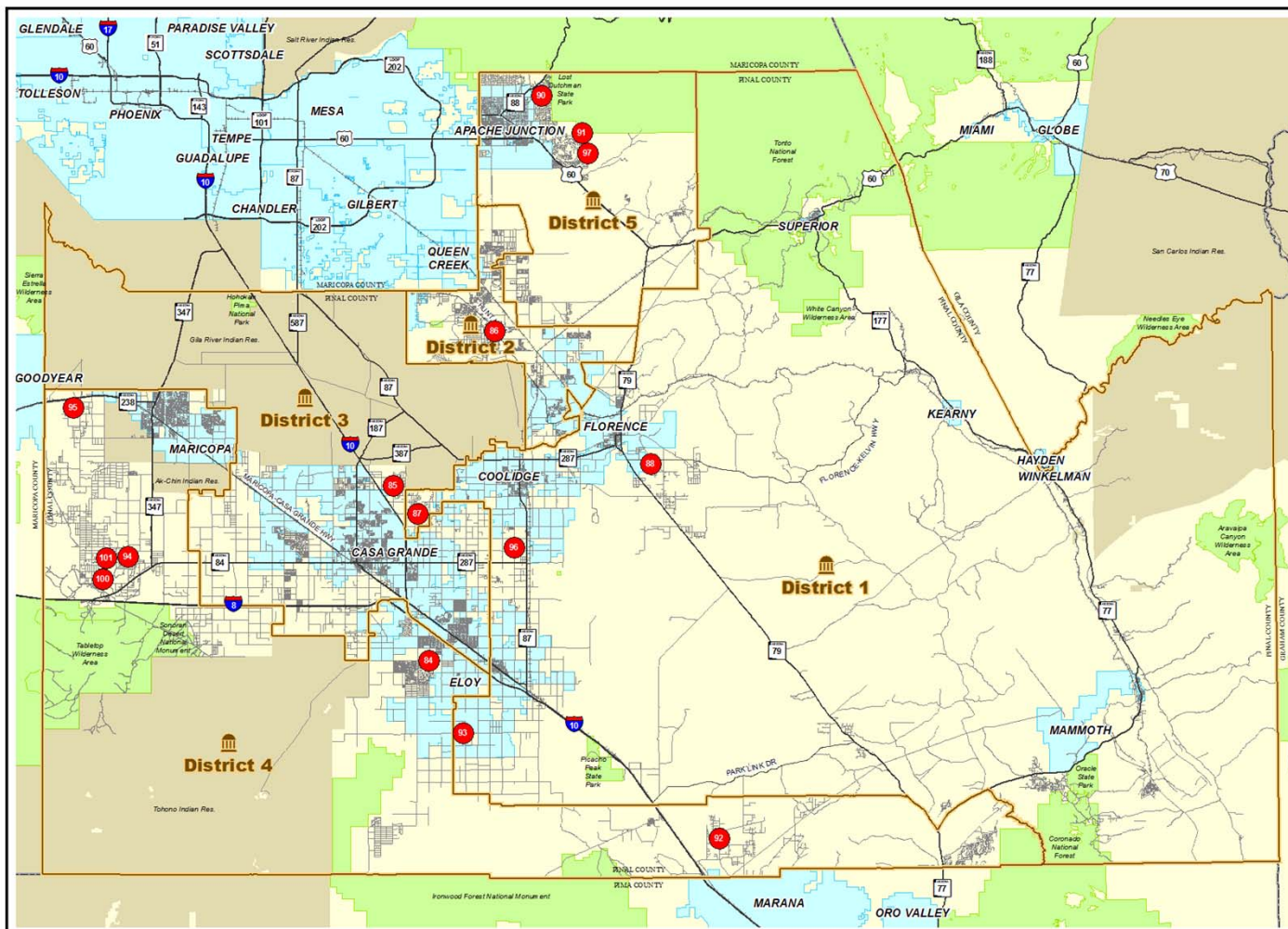

**Introduction**

The Pinal County Transportation Advisory Committee ("TAC") is a recommending body to the Pinal County Board of Supervisors ("BOS") on transportation planning, construction, and major maintenance projects within the county's jurisdictional boundaries. The TAC consists of ten qualified electors of Pinal County, two members from each of Pinal County's five supervisory districts, who are appointed by the BOS to serve a four-year term. The TAC annually reviews, updates, and recommends a five-year Transportation Improvement and Maintenance Program ("TIMP") to the BOS.

**Process for submitting a Transportation Project Request**

**Transportation Projects Requests**

Transportation project requests for consideration in the TIMP are accepted throughout the year. All project requests must be completed on Pinal County's Transportation Project Request Form and submitted to Public Works staff via the county website, mail, telephone or in person at the Public Works Department in Florence or BOS satellite offices. Please note, requests received after September 30th of each year, will be considered for inclusion in the following year's TIMP.

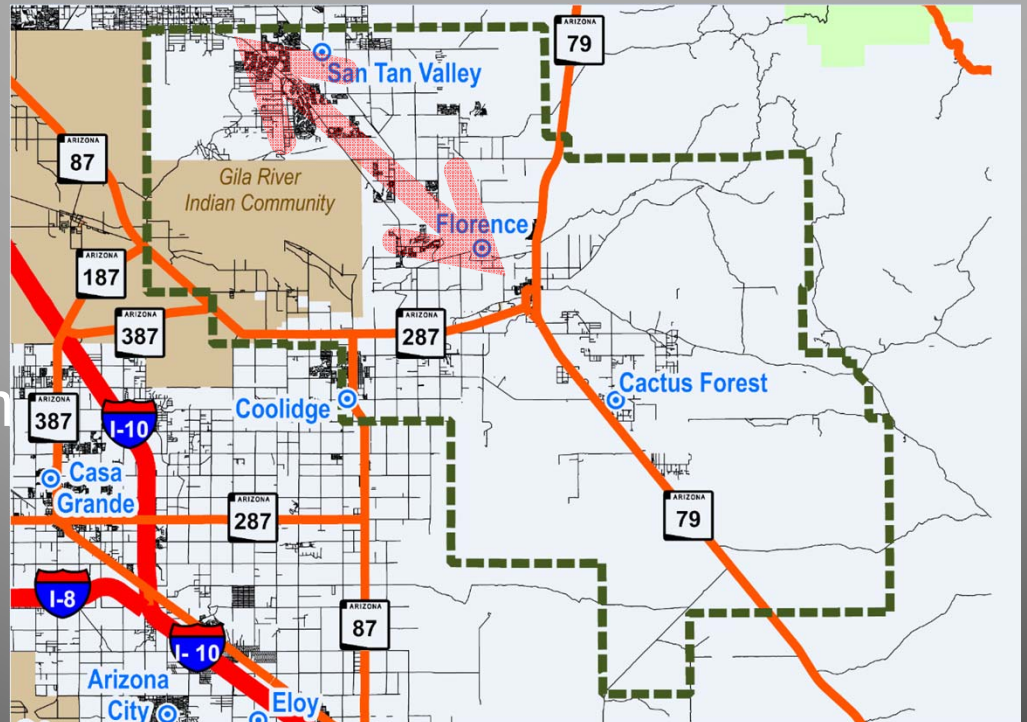

# Hunt Highway Widening Project

- ▶ Pinal County's highest transportation priority
  - 4 lanes with median and turn lanes
  - Phased Implementation





# Hunt Highway Phasing



## Phase I – Empire Blvd–Thompson Rd

- Roadway design is complete
- \$5.8 million of construction funding (federal) is allocated
- Construction beginning November 12, 2013

## Phase II – Thompson Rd–Gary Rd

- Roadway design is complete
- \$4 million of construction funding budgeted for Fiscal Year 2013–2014
- Construction planned for Summer 2014



## Phase III – Gary Rd–Bella Vista Rd

- Roadway design is 30% complete with plans reviewed by county staff & returned to design consultant
- \$190,000 of design funding is allocated
- \$2–4 million of construction funding has not been identified

## Phase IV – Bella Vista Rd–Magma Rd

- Roadway design is 30% complete with plans reviewed by county staff & returned to design consultant
- \$300,000 of design funding is allocated
- \$8–12 million of construction funding has not been identified

# Other Construction Projects



## Gantzel Rd (Phase D) Bella Vista Rd–Hunt Hwy

- 4 lanes with median turn lane
- Roadway design is 60% complete & expected for review December 1, 2013
- \$400,000 of design funding is currently allocated
- \$4–7 million of construction funding has not been identified



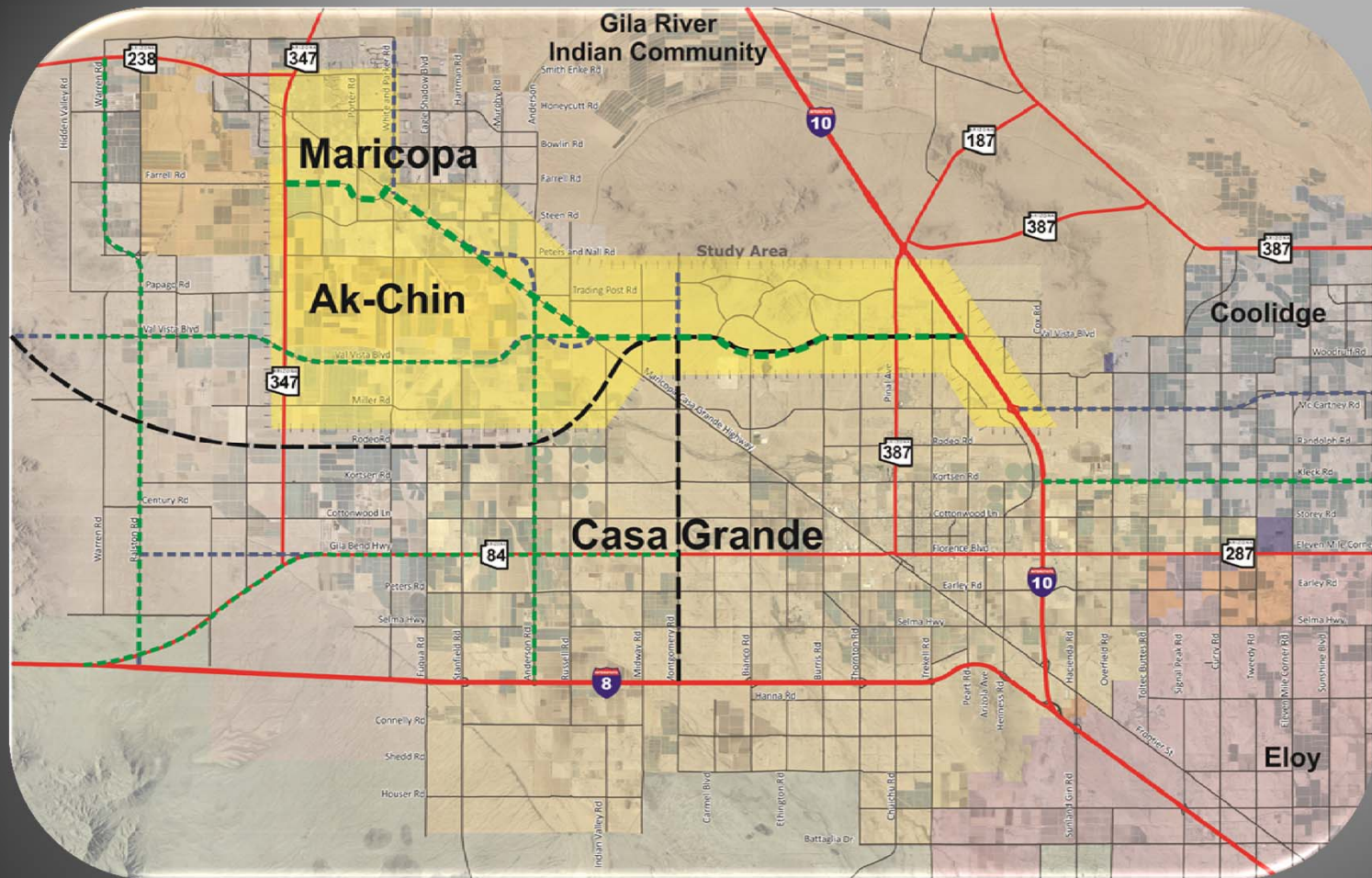
## Skyline Rd & Gary Rd Intersection

- Traffic signal
- Design is complete with plans approved
- Project has been put out for bid
- Construction planned for Early 2014

## Empire Blvd & Gary Rd Intersection

- Traffic signal
- Project is being administered by Maricopa County
- Construction planned for Summer 2014
- Pinal County to restripe intersection (interim) November 14 & 15, 2013
